Terms & Conditions



General

1. Charges are payable at Pen-y-fan Caravan Park's office. No receipt is valid unless it is given on their official form of receipt. Site allocations are made and payments accepted on the strict understanding that caravan owners agree to the charges and conditions herein.
2. Caravans are accommodated in the park and occupied entirely at the caravan owners risk. The Company will not be responsible for any loss, damage, theft or mishap, however caused. Owners are advised not to leave valuables in their caravans and at all times to insure contents and caravan. Clothing, personal effects and articles of special value must be specifically listed and covered.
3. Occupiers of caravans must have due regard to the comfort and convenience of other occupiers and residents and refrain from causing any disturbance in or outside of the park. Occupiers are particularly requested to remain quiet when passing through the park at night. Gambling, Intoxication and any other improper behaviour is expressly forbidden. Musical instruments, TV's and radios must not be used after **11PM**, Or at any other time to the inconvenience of others.
4. Ball and other games likely to cause annoyance are prohibited near caravans.
5. Speed of vehicles driven in the park shall not exceed **FIVE miles per hour**.
6. The Company shall have the right to refuse occupation of a pitch by anyone who, in their opinion is for any reason undesirable.
7. In the event of misconduct or breach of these conditions the agreement may be terminated forthwith and the Company shall then have the right to remove the caravan from it's site. In such an event no part of any paid site charge will be refundable.

IN CASE OF FIRE

1. Ensure the caravan or building involved is evacuated.
2. Turn off outside gas valve and disconnect electrical supply
3. Ring the Fire Brigade giving them exact locations within the park
4. Fire fighting equipment is provided at the points marked on the site map.

- 8 All dogs must be kept under control and owners of dogs fouling the area may be subject to fines. You may walk your dogs anywhere in the wild area below the camping fields and behind the storage compounds. Any dogs in public places must be with their owner and leashed.
- 9 The Boundary hedge, fencing and bank may not be interfered with in any way whatsoever, except with written permission of the Company
- 10 TV Aerials may only be erected with the permission of and in a manner suitable to the Company.
- 11 Please ensure that the electrical supply is disconnected when your caravan is stored on site and not occupied. Contact the office to make alternative arrangements. This does not apply to metered electricity.
- 12 Please be aware the electric breakers on this caravan park are only 10amp for touring caravans. Therefore domestic equipment such as kettles, Microwaves or even irons if used while your TV is on will blow the Main fuses. We do not have an electrician on site to rectify the problem should you overload the circuits. Any call out may be charged to the customer if the fault is found to be theirs.

TOILETS

1. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult
2. We request that you do not wear dirty boots inside the toilet block.
3. Ensure shower and shower lights are switched off after use/
4. In the interests of hygiene please leave these facilities as you would wish to find them. Continued misuse will result in offenders being asked to leave the site.

The managements decision is final. A copy of the full conditions is available in reception.


CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG
